# What are the current/upcoming Open Calls?

## **KTE - Knowledge Transfer Experiments**

One **Sending** Academic/Industrial partner sends a member of its staff to one **Host** Academic/Industrial partner for an internship project to transfer knowledge.

- **Project Duration: 3 months**

**OPEN until 15 June**

## **FTTE - Focused Technology Transfer Experiments**

One Academic/Industrial **Technology Provider** transfers to an Industrial **Technology Receiver** a specific Hardware or Software technology in order to enable an improvement in product or processes.

- **Project Duration: 9 months**

**OPENS on 15 July**

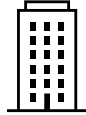

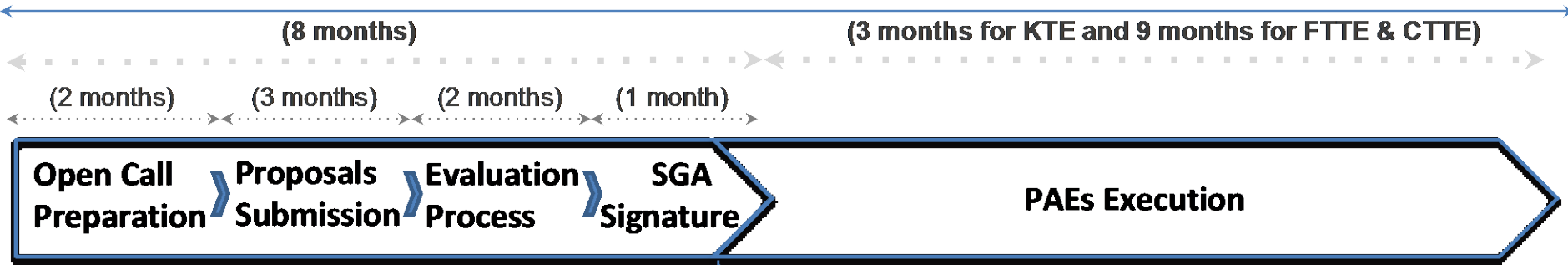

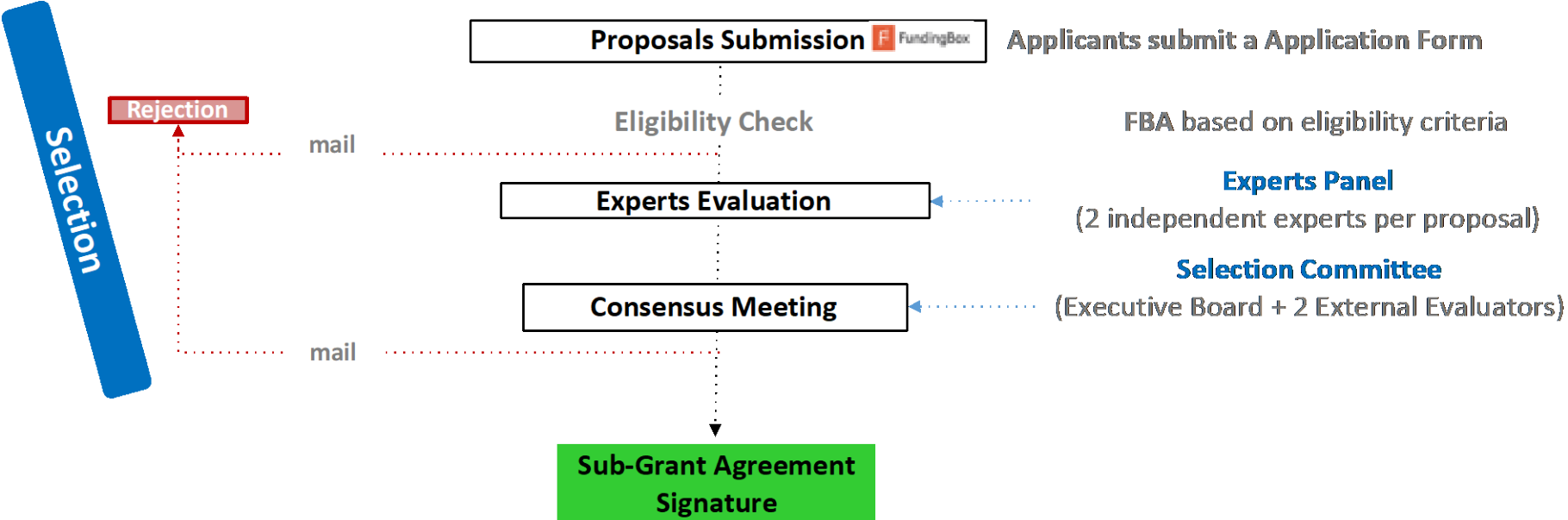

# Evaluation Criteria - KTE

Criteria	Description
<b>Excellence</b>	<b>Quality and credibility of innovation project:</b> Level of novelty and appropriate consideration of the vertical applications of the proposed KTE.
	<b>Quality and appropriateness of the knowledge sharing</b> among the participating organisations in light of the research and innovation objectives.
	<b>Quality of the proposed interaction</b> between the participating organisations.
<b>Impact</b>	<b>Enhancement of the potential and future career of the staff member</b> being sent to the Host organisation.
	<b>Development of new and lasting research collaborations</b> between participating organisations.
	<b>Exploitation and disseminate the project results</b> , focusing on the SMART4ALL marketplace.
	<b>Market potential of the proposed knowledge transfer</b> in one of the SMART4ALL verticals and competition analysis.
	<b>Communicate the project activities</b> to different target audiences and their delivery (in terms of repository in SMART4ALL marketplace)
	<b>Impact on sensitive social groups</b> , improving or supporting the quality of their lives.

# Evaluation Criteria - KTE

Criteria	Description
<b>Implementation</b>	<b>Coherence and effectiveness of the Work Plan</b> , including appropriateness of tasks and resources allocation. Workplan to be clearly described and fully aligned with the objectives; time plan realistic and achievable.
	<b>Appropriateness of resources allocation:</b> compliance with i) the applicable national law and taxes, labour and social security and ii) the principle of a sound financial management regarding economy and efficiency.
	<b>Competences, experience, complementarity and commitment</b> of the participating organisations.
	<b>Contribution to SMART4ALL marketplace:</b> All SMART4ALL funded PAEs are required to contribute at least one artefact to the project Marketplace ( <a href="https://marketplace.smart4all-project.eu">https://marketplace.smart4all-project.eu</a> )

# Prioritised Sub-Criteria (SEE Countries)

- Each criterion will be scored from 0 to 5. The threshold for individual criteria will be 3. The overall threshold, applied to the weighted sum of the three individual scores, will be 10. (Impact in KTE -> 1.5 weight)
- Applicants including at least 1 member of the **SEE region** in their consortium will be given **1 extra point** to the overall score (with the exception of Greece).

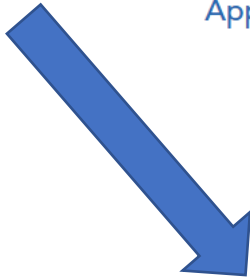
